

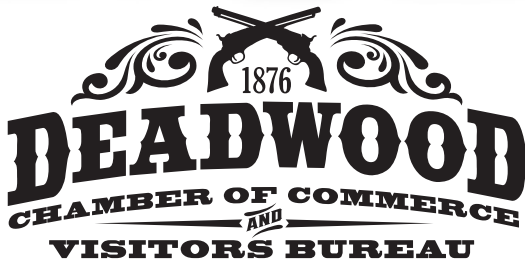

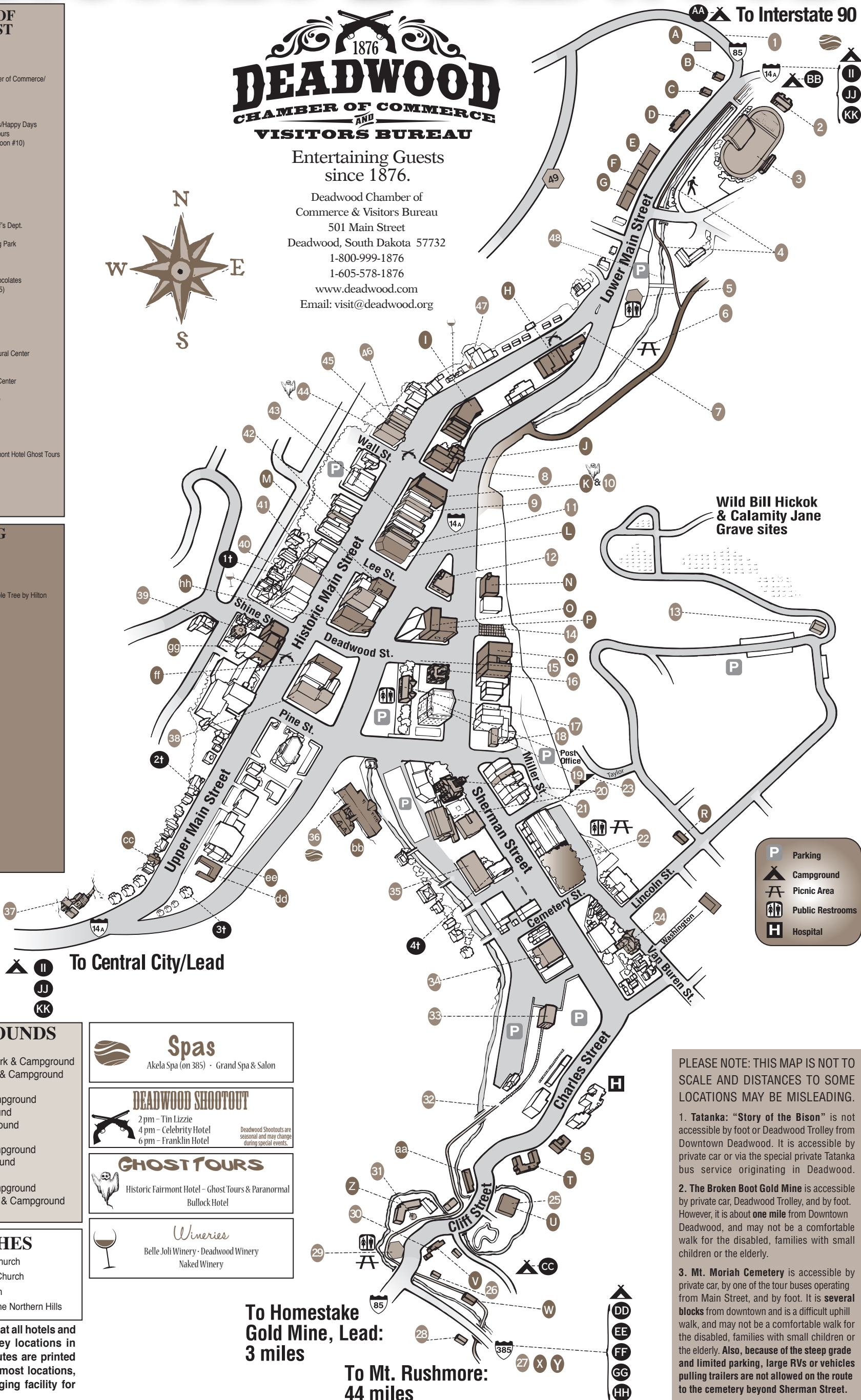
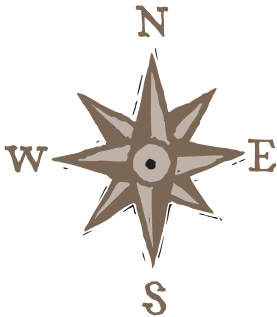

1. **Tatanka: "Story of the Bison"** is not accessible by foot or Deadwood Trolley from Downtown Deadwood. It is accessible by private car or via the special private Tatanka bus service originating in Deadwood.

2. **The Broken Boot Gold Mine** is accessible by private car, Deadwood Trolley, and by foot. However, it is about **one mile** from Downtown Deadwood, and may not be a comfortable walk for the disabled, families with small children or the elderly.

3. **Mt. Moriah Cemetery** is accessible by private car, by one of the tour buses operating from Main Street, and by foot. It is **several blocks** from downtown and is a difficult uphill walk, and may not be a comfortable walk for the disabled, families with small children or the elderly. **Also, because of the steep grade and limited parking, large RVs or vehicles pulling trailers are not allowed on the route to the cemetery beyond Sherman Street.**
