

## Talking Points For Sports Wagering

- 1. We are asking the legislature to place on the ballot for voters of South Dakota to decide if they want safe, regulated sports betting available to them.
- 2. If approved, this legislature will decide the manner of implementing sports wagering in South Dakota.
- 3. Sports wagering is an additional game type.
- 4. We must compete with surrounding gaming jurisdictions' offerings. Sports wagering is doing extremely well in Iowa, and it will be starting in March in Montana and in May in Colorado.
- 5. According to the American Gaming Association, 14 states currently have legal sports wagering, with 6 states and the District of Columbia having already authorized sports wagering, while another 12 states have active legislation on sports wagering.
- 6. Sports wagering is currently happening in South Dakota <u>ILLEGALLY!</u> When given the option, we believe South Dakotans want to place their sports wagers in a safe, legal and regulated environment.
- 7. Deadwood gaming just celebrated our 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary this year. Our success has been tied to keeping our promises with the voters of South Dakota and creating a fun, safe gaming destination for them to enjoy.
