## Modified Table Game Operations

It is the desire of the entire Deadwood casino industry to provide for a safe and healthy gaming environment for patrons and employees alike. Pursuant to Section 1(E)(3) of Deadwood Municipal Ordinance 1312, the Deadwood Gaming Association offers the following plan for complying with CDC COVID-19 guidelines.

- Deadwood licensed gaming operators will provide for access to and require the proper wearing of personal protective equipment (PPE) that will cover the nose and mouth while performing duties that require direct engagement with the gaming public where 6' of spacing is not easily achievable.
- A specific enhanced cleaning plan must be implemented, and employees must be trained in proper sanitation practices for all contact surfaces including cards, chips, dice and tokens. Procedures and materials are available at [www.cdc.gov](http://www.cdc.gov).
- Gaming operators will provide for 6 foot spacing among table game patrons by reducing the number of seats at a table.
- Hand sanitizer must be available to the public and accessible by the employee at each table game open for play.
- Table game play will continue to be in compliance with all South Dakota Commission on Gaming rules and regulations.
