WELCOME TO DEADWOOD

Make a Deadwood information location your first stop when you get to town. The Deadwood Welcome Center (501 Main Street) features parking, an indoor trolley waiting area, creek access and loads of great information to help plan your stay and activities. Additional information locations include the History and Information Center (historic train depot at 3 Siever Street) and the Information Wagon (seasonal, a historic chuckwagon that travels to various locations on Main Street).

Once you've parked and have a plan, hop on a Deadwood Trolley. Rides only cost \$1 – \$2 per person, per ride and the trolleys' loop routes mean you'll rarely walk more than a couple blocks before reaching a boarding location. Trolleys run morning into night, picking up at each location throughout the day. Hours and frequency change seasonally. Trolleys can be tracked in real-time at TrackMyTrolley.com.

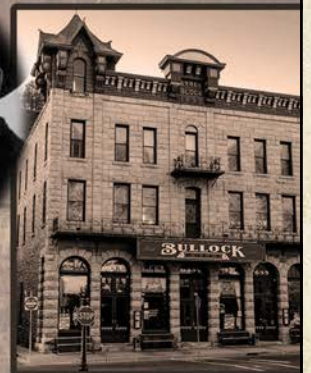

GET LUCKY IN DEADWOOD

In 1876, thousands of prospectors descended upon Deadwood Gulch. The promise of gold and a better life inspired a flood of fortune-seekers into the canyons and peaks of the Lakota's sacred Black Hills.



Though many gold rush towns died almost as soon as they started, Deadwood was different. The nearby mines went through booms and busts, but the gold kept coming. Generations of miners toiled underground, and when their shifts were over, they came to Deadwood saloons, brothels and gambling halls to unwind and relax.

It didn't matter that this was all mostly illegal; Deadwood had always been a town on the edge of the law, and the people who came for a good time didn't mind bending a rule or two.

Things changed in 1989. After more than a century of gambling on the down-low,



NOT SURE WHERE TO START?

Here's a quick primer on the kinds of games you'll find in Deadwood.

Deadwood became the third place in the United States (after Atlantic City and the state of Nevada) to allow legal gaming. The card tables and slot machines came out from the back rooms, and the town boomed. Fueled by the new tax revenue, the town began an ambitious historic preservation

effort that continues today. Gaming expanded again in 2015, when roulette and craps joined the town's existing poker tables, blackjack games and slot machines. And in 2021, sports wagering was added to the lineup. Visit Deadwood.com/casinos for more information.

SLOT MACHINES

Slot machines are the most common casino game in Deadwood, but the games are as diverse as they are universal. Penny slots are the crowd favorite, with a multitude of betting options that makes the game fun and low-cost. Progressive systems link the same machines throughout town creating an ever-growing jackpot amount. And many machines have the flexibility of being multi-denomination, so your desired bet changes with the click of a button.



POKER

A good poker game in Deadwood is always available, but you'll have to search a little longer than you do for slots. A handful of casinos offer live poker games, and the play at them is outstanding. The most popular flavors are Texas Hold 'em and Omaha, both community card games. Depending on times, games start with blinds as low as \$2 and \$4. There's a variety of additional table games offered in Deadwood, such as Let It Ride, Caribbean Stud, Ultimate Texas Hold-em, 3-Card, 4-Card and more. If you're unfamiliar with the game, stop in a casino

that offers poker during a slower time of day; most dealers will be happy to help you learn the basics.

BLACKJACK

Blackjack, also called 21, is a game that's easy to learn, making it the most popular casino game in the world. You'll find blackjack at most of the medium-size and larger gaming venues in Deadwood. While most games use multiple decks, if you ask around you'll find some single-deck tables, which give the house a significantly smaller advantage. Ask most any gaming professional and they'll tell you blackjack offers the best odds in the house.

SPORTS WAGERING

The game has changed, literally. Sports wagering is available at half dozen locations – with more quickly rolling out all the time, and lets gamers bet on the next big sporting event. Sports fans can grab their friends, enjoy great food, place a bet, watch the game and maybe walk away with a little more cash. ROULETTE

Roulette has been spinning in Deadwood since 2015. Roulette can be found at the town's larger gaming venues. Another easy game to learn, your roulette strategy can be kept simple by betting on red or black, on odds or evens, or up the potential winnings by selecting particular numbers. Then, just sit back and watch the wheel do the work.

CRAPS

Like blackjack, craps is one of the most popular casino games in the world. If there's crowd gathered at any casino, you can almost bet it's around a craps table. Craps is played by one player, or a group betting against the house. Though the board and action can look intimidating, the game is easy to learn and fun to play.

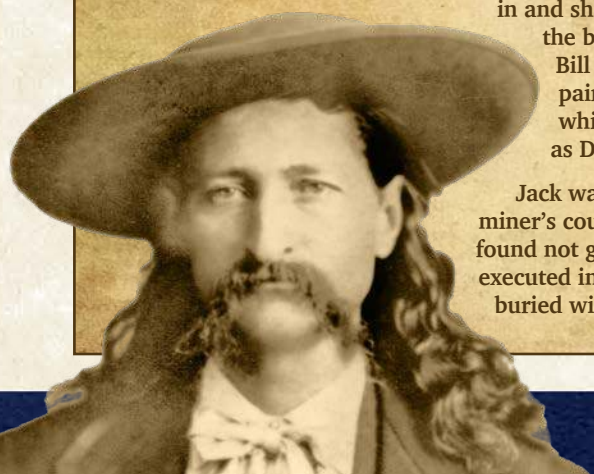
HISTORY NUGGETS

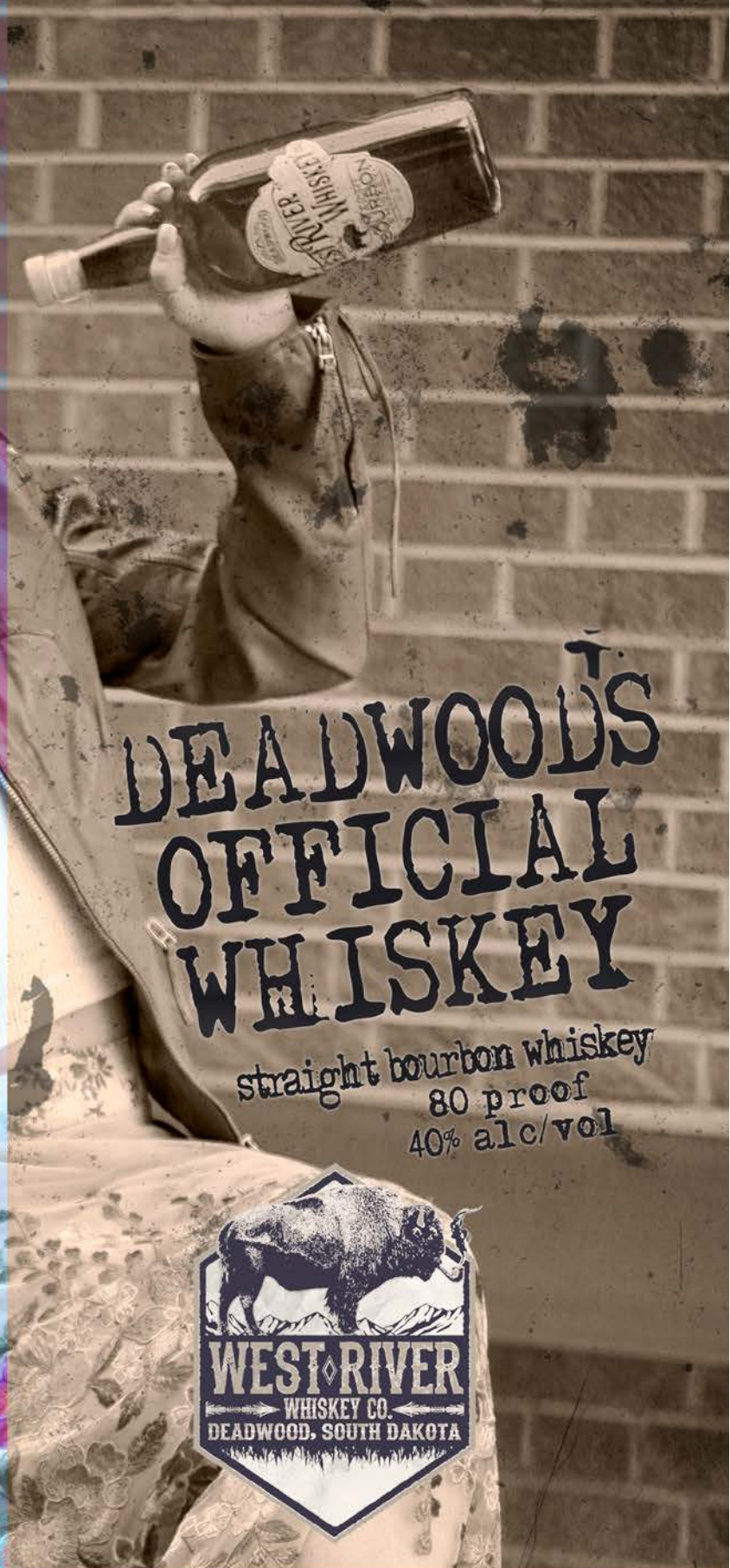
WILD BILL HICKOK

Although Wild Bill Hickok is Deadwood's most famous resident, he was in town less than a month before he was shot down by Jack McCall on August 2, 1876.

The former gunfighter and lawman was famous long before Deadwood. He arrived by wagon train from Cheyenne in the company of Charlie Utter and Calamity Jane. Despite talk of prospecting for gold, Wild Bill didn't stray from the Badlands, a section of Main Street known for its bars, brothels and gambling houses. He was playing poker in Nuttal & Mann's (Saloon No. 10) when Jack McCall walked in and shot Wild Bill in the back of the head. Bill was holding two pair, Aces and Eights, which became known as Dead Man's Hand.

Jack was first tried by a miner's court in Deadwood and found not guilty. He was later tried and executed in Yankton, the territorial capital, and buried with the noose still around his neck.



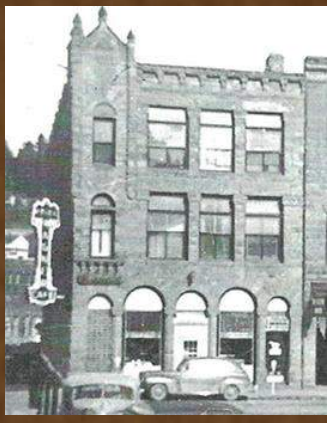

LEARN ABOUT THE
OLD WEST
IN DEADWOOD

Deadwood was born in 1876, when a rush of gold miners and fortune seekers descended on the Northern Black Hills in the hopes of making a better life for themselves. The town was practically lawless in those early years, and the men and women who first came to Deadwood were people of fortitude and strength - folks who didn't mind a little struggle on the road to fame and fortune.



These folks were responsible for a number of lasting legends. The dime novel exploits of Wild Bill, Calamity Jane, Deadwood Dick and other heroes captivated turn-of-the-20th-century America. In many ways they still define modern Deadwood.

That means that when you visit Deadwood, you're diving head-first into living history.

You don't have to pore over old records or listen to lectures to know what Deadwood was like 147 years ago — though you can. Just walk the brick-paved streets, and you'll immerse yourself in continental America's last great gold rush.

That's why True West Magazine has named Deadwood one of the Top 10 True West Towns, as well as Best Old West

Gunfighter Town, Best Town for Historic Entertainment and Best Historic Cemetery of the West.

WANT TO LEARN MORE?

There are plenty of ways to put yourself in Deadwood's Wild West past.

BROTHEL TOURS

Deadwood's last houses of prostitution closed following a raid in 1980. But now, visitors are able to tour one of these former bordellos at The Brothel, located at 610 Main Street, and understand how the world's oldest profession shaped more than a century of Deadwood's history.



DEADWOOD WALKING TOUR

Pick up a free brochure for this self-guided tour at one of Deadwood's visitor centers, or at City Hall, 108 Sherman Street. Also, interpretive signs at important locations will tell short stories from Deadwood's past. Scan the QR codes with your smartphone to see rare photographs and videos.



special events such as musical performances and history lectures during the summer on the lawn.

ADAMS MUSEUM

The oldest history museum in the Black Hills, the Adams Museum at 54 Sherman Street originally had a Victorian cabinet-of-curiosities philosophy: collect anything that looks cool and put it in a glass case. The museum still has an eclectic collection, including a one-of-a-kind plesiosaur



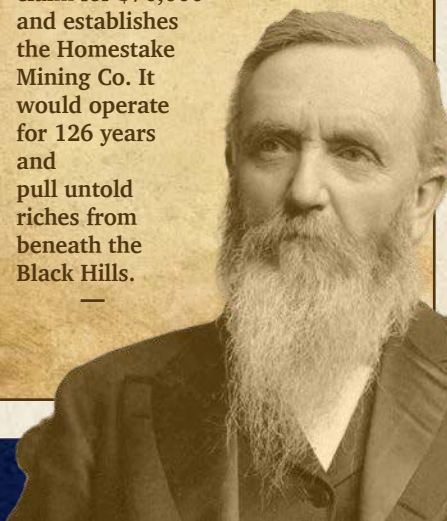
HISTORY OF DEADWOOD TIME LINE

1874 Col. George Armstrong Custer's expedition discovers gold on French Creek in the Southern Hills.

1875 A much richer gold deposit is discovered in Deadwood Gulch. The town of Custer is abandoned and miners stream north to stake claims.

1876 Deadwood becomes an official town, although rough around the edges. Wild Bill Hickok is gunned down, and the Manuel brothers strike gold near present-day Lead.

1877 Mining mogul George Hearst buys the Manuel brothers' claim for \$70,000 and establishes the Homestake Mining Co. It would operate for 126 years and pull untold riches from beneath the Black Hills.



HISTORIC ADAMS HOUSE

Built in 1892, the Queen Anne home at 22 Van Buren Street was occupied by some of Deadwood's most influential merchant families. Its furnishings, hand-painted canvas wall coverings, stained glass windows and 19th-century plumbing sat undisturbed for almost 60 years during the middle of the 20th century. Guided tours of the fully restored home are open April through October. Ask about

1890 The Fremont, Elkhorn & Missouri Valley Railroad begins passenger service to Deadwood.



1903 The Franklin Hotel opens; Calamity Jane dies.

1906 The Homestake Slime Plant (now the Deadwood Mountain Grand) is constructed.

1908 The Lawrence County Courthouse is completed.

1913 The Deadwood Auditorium (now the Deadwood Recreation Center) opens to the public.

1929 Potato Creek Johnny reportedly finds a 7 3/4-ounce gold nugget, one of the largest ever found in the Black Hills.

1930 The Adams Memorial Hall Museum opens.

1961 The entire town of Deadwood is declared a National Historic Landmark.

1980 The last four brothels are shut down by federal authorities.

fossil, Potato Creek Johnny's massive gold nugget, the mysterious Thoen Stone and a mining locomotive. The recently renovated museum features modern displays that use artifacts to tell the important stories of Deadwood's past. Ask about special programs and temporary exhibits. Open year-round.

DAYS OF '76 MUSEUM

Located at 18 Seventy Six Drive, the newly built Days of '76 Museum has a large collection of horse-drawn wagons, coaches, carriages, 19th-century clothing, firearms, and Native American artifacts. The 32,000-square-foot building is a cool and quiet place to uncover some of Deadwood's earliest stories. Open year-round.

OLD STYLE SALOON NO. 10 & THE TRIAL OF JACK MCCALL*

Though the original location of the bar where Wild Bill Hickok met his end is farther down the street, the modern Saloon No. 10 (657 Main Street) has been embracing the legacy of Deadwood's most famous permanent

resident for decades. There are so many historic photos and oddball artifacts hanging from the walls and ceiling that the establishment often markets itself as "the only museum in the world with a bar." From late-May through late-September, Monday through Saturday, the saloon re-enacts the events of Wild Bill's final card game several times a day. These shows are free. From Memorial weekend through late September, after the last performance at 7:30 p.m., actors chase the murderer down the street and haul him off to a trial.

DEADWOOD ALIVE*

The actors who perform at the Trial of Jack McCall* also stage shootouts* and fun, audience-participation shows up and down Main Street during the summer months every day except Sunday. The shows are free and designed with families in mind. Plan an extra evening of fun and learning in Deadwood with the whole family and enjoy Deadwood History Family Fun Night at Outlaw Square on Tuesday evenings in the summer.

Immerse yourself in history and take a ride on Main Street on the Deadwood Stagecoach*. Rides are available daily, in the summer and on weekends in the





spring and fall (weather and special events permitting). Tickets are purchased at Outlaw Square at 703 Main Street.

MOUNT MORIAH CEMETERY

Deadwood's first cemetery found plenty of involuntary occupants in 1876 and 1877, but the needs of the town's living residents soon prevailed over the deceased. The cemetery was moved to its present location at the top of Lincoln Avenue, and the old cemetery site was built over with houses. The well-traveled cemetery's lanes are broad and paved, but you can hike up to some of the wilder parts of the forested graveyard, including Seth Bullock's grave near the top of the mountain (about a 15-minute walk up a gravel forest service road). Be sure to stop at the graves of Calamity Jane and Wild Bill Hickok, the



Chinese section and the paupers' sections. Admission is \$2 and includes a handy map of the cemetery at the entrance. You can pay a bit more for a guided bus tour during the summer - just look for the kiosks downtown. The cemetery is open from dawn to dusk year-round.

TATANKA: STORY OF THE BISON

Over 30 million Bison once roamed the Great Plains of North America. By the close of the 19th century, less than 1,000 bison survived. At Tatanka: Story of the Bison, you will discover the fascinating history, the cultural importances and the inspiring comeback of the majestic mammal. Located one mile north of Deadwood on U.S. Highway 85, the attraction includes a larger than life bronze sculpture featuring 14 bison pursued by three Native American riders, Northern Plains Peoples Educational Interpretive Center, Native American Gift Shop, Dances with Wolves movie costumes, and Lakota Interpretive presentations.

HISTORY OF DEADWOOD TIME LINE



1987 Fire destroys the Syndicate Block, fueling the discussion about legalized gaming to preserve Deadwood's historic buildings.

1989 Legalized gaming kicks off with slot machines, blackjack and poker. Deadwood is the first jurisdiction outside Nevada and Atlantic City to offer gaming.

1998 The Mickelson Trail, running 109 miles along a former rail line from Deadwood to Edgemont, is completed.

2002 After 126 years, mined to depths of 8,000 feet, the Homestake Gold Mine shuts down. (It's now the Sanford Underground Lab.)

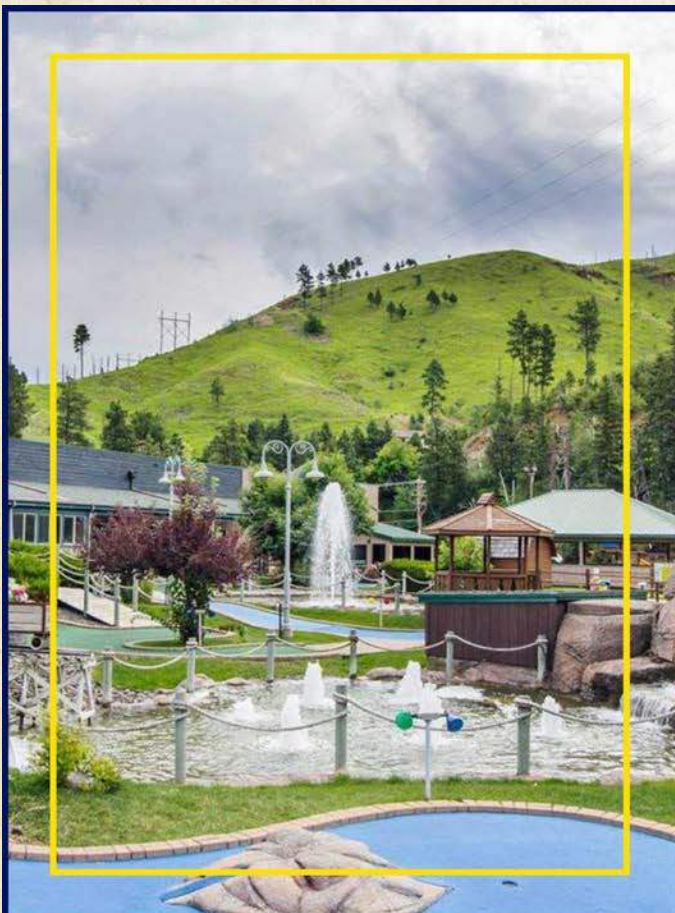

If you've spent enough time in the office chair or the car for one day, there are plenty of ways to get up and moving. Whether you want to golf, hike or swim, there is plenty of action to be found in town!



WINTER ACTIVITIES

With more than 150 inches of snowfall annually, the Black Hills brims with winter adventures for all ages and skill levels. Enjoy downhill skiing and snowboarding at nearby Terry Peak Ski Area. Cross-country skiing and snowshoeing more your style? Then you'll discover a wide variety of trails with a range of difficulty near Cheyenne Crossing, at the junction of U.S. Hwy 85 and beautiful Spearfish Canyon. Rev your engine and ride on hundreds of miles of nearby snowmobile trails, including a spur that runs into Deadwood city limits. If you don't have your own machine, several area outfitters rent snowmobiles.



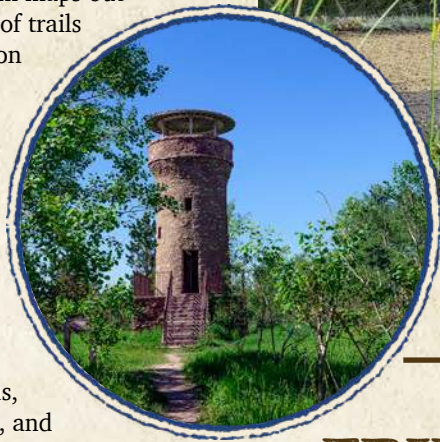
HIKE, BIKE OR SKI THE MICKELSON TRAIL

If you're ready for a longer walk, jog or bike ride, the northernmost trailhead of the 109-mile Mickelson Trail departs from the heart of Deadwood. Follow this

former railroad line past historic mining buildings, over gurgling creeks and into the Black Hills. During snowy months, parts of the trail are excellent for cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, and even snowmobiling in designated areas. Passes are available at stations along the trail, a Deadwood Visitor Center or online.

URBAN TRAIL SYSTEM

The Urban Trail System maps out over a hundred miles of trails including the Mickelson and Homestake Trails. Within the communities of Lead and Deadwood themselves, trails ranging from short walks up to a 10-mile loop are available. These trails pass through historic neighborhoods, up hillside cemeteries, and through forested paths on the edge of town. Maps are available for download at www.cityofdeadwood.com.

CLIMB THE FRIENDSHIP TOWER ON MOUNT ROOSEVELT

Another hiking option is a short and beautiful hike up to the Friendship Tower, a monument built by Seth Bullock to honor his friend Theodore Roosevelt in 1919. The tower was restored in 2010, and visitors may now climb the spiral staircase to the top for stunning views

across the Black Hills. The trailhead for this hike is located 1.5 miles north on U.S. Highway 85. Turn west on Forest Service Road 133 and continue about 2 miles to the parking area.

DEADWOOD REC CENTER

Deadwood's Rec Center offers a full range of exercise and family fun options, including an indoor pool, walking and running track, cardio room, weight room, basketball and racquetball courts. Call **605-578-3729** for more information.

HOMESTAKE TRAIL

Created by the Northern Hills Recreation Association, this new trail winds along the old Homestake Railroad grade, and is great for hiking and biking. The 3-mile Homestake Trail starts at the Dog Park in

HISTORY NUGGETS

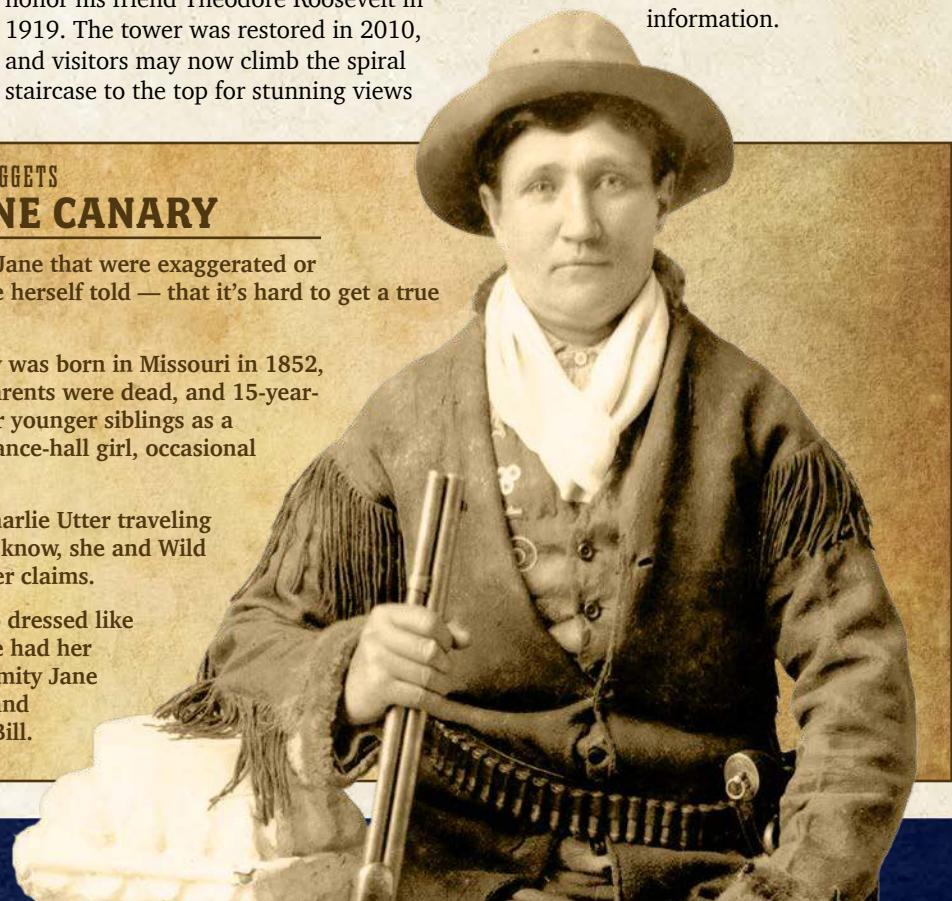
CALAMITY JANE CANARY

There are so many stories about Calamity Jane that were exaggerated or downright false — especially the ones Jane herself told — that it's hard to get a true picture of this legendary character.

Here's what we know: Martha Jane Canary was born in Missouri in 1852, the oldest of six children. By 1867, both parents were dead, and 15-year-old Jane, living in Wyoming, supported her younger siblings as a dishwasher, cook, nurse, ox team driver, dance-hall girl, occasional lady of the night and later Army scout.

In 1876 she joined Wild Bill Hickok and Charlie Utter traveling by wagon train to Deadwood. As far as we know, she and Wild Bill were not terribly close, despite her later claims.

She was a wild, hard-drinking woman who dressed like a man and swore better than most. But she had her compassionate side, tending the sick. Calamity Jane died in the nearby town of Terry in 1903, and was buried at Mount Moriah next to Wild Bill.



BE ENTERTAINED

YEAR-ROUND IN DEADWOOD

Deadwood's Wild West past has never gone completely to sleep, and throughout the year you'll find that Deadwood is as entertaining as it was in 1876, regardless of the season.



Entertainment isn't necessarily a spectator sport in Deadwood. You can sit on the jury at the trial of Jack McCall, Wild Bill Hickok's murderer, then head to the poker table to show off your talents.

By the way, November to April are great times to get a good deal on lodging, even on weekends. Except for special events, hotels, motels and inns offer steeply discounted rooms.

TRIAL OF JACK MCCALL

During the Summer, witness a replay of one of the most famous crimes in Western history every evening, except Sundays, in downtown Deadwood. The evening begins at 7:35 p.m. when Jack McCall, Wild Bill's killer, is captured in front of the Saloon No. 10. shortly after doing the deed. Justice in Deadwood is indeed swift — at 8 p.m. Jack goes on trial just up the street. Space is limited. Reserve your ticket at DeadwoodAlive.com or call 800-344-8826. Tickets are also available while



supplies last at the Information Wagon on the day of the show.

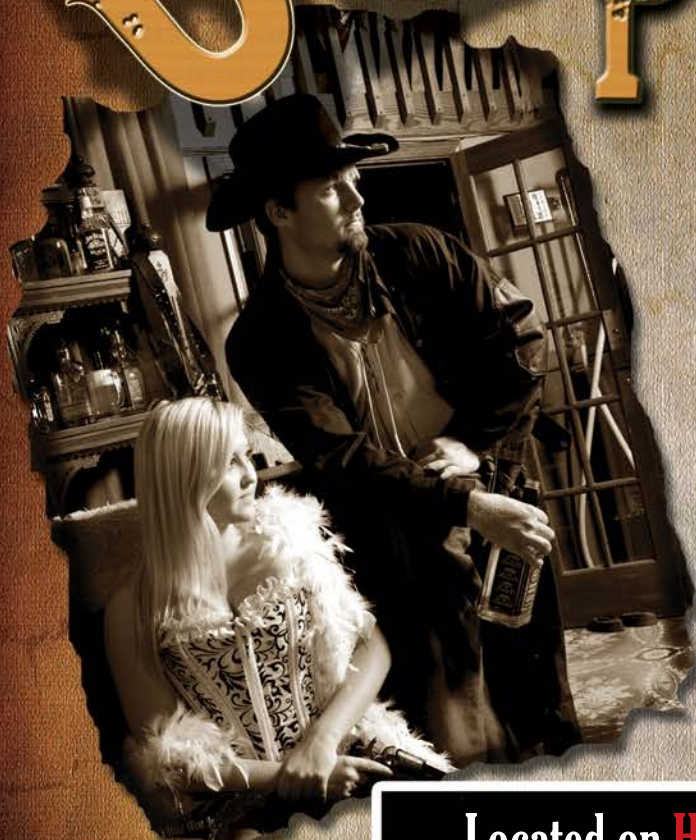

On the corner of Main and Deadwood Streets - at the very center of town - you'll find the newest family-friendly entertainment venue in Deadwood: Outlaw Square.



The square was created by the community as a local gathering space for public events. Historically, the City of Deadwood had a number of these plazas, including a Victorian bandstand on Sherman Street and Chautauqua Park on the top of McGovern Hill. But as the decades wore on, these spaces succumbed to age and redevelopment, and modern Deadwood has been without a public square. Until now.

Outlaw Square opened in November 2019. It's located on the former site of Deadwood's City Hall and the Deadwood Theater, grand Victorian-era public buildings that were destroyed by a tragic fire in 1952. It's also less than 100 feet from the confluence of Whitewood Creek, City Creek, and Deadwood Creek, where gold was first discovered in Deadwood Gulch in late 1875 - an event that opened the floodgates to the prospectors, entrepreneurs, and gamblers who built Deadwood into one of the West's most legendary towns.

Outlaw Square operates year-round, hosting concerts, skating and bumper cars (winter), movie nights, craft fairs, holiday celebrations, history presentations, and more.

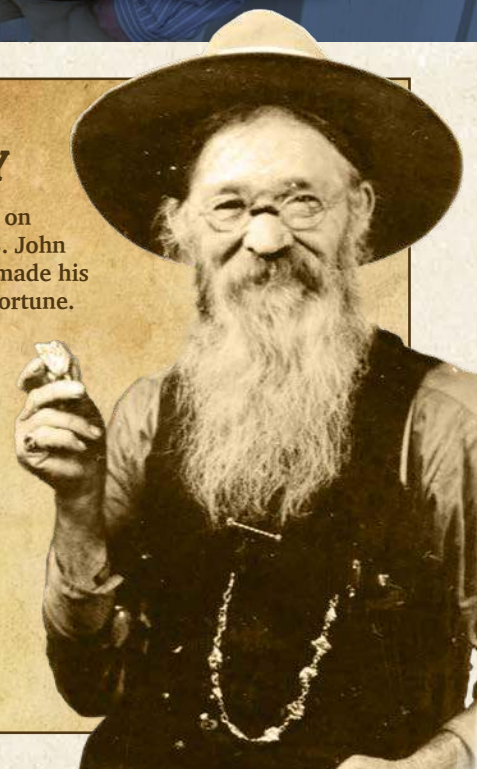
HISTORY NUGGETS

POTATO CREEK JOHNNY

This diminutive prospector was a familiar sight on
the streets of Deadwood until his death in 1943. John
Perrett immigrated from Wales and eventually made his
way to the Black Hills in the 1880s to seek his fortune.

Although most gold mining by then had gone
underground, Johnny spent years using gold
pans and sluice boxes to work his surface
claim along Potato Creek, a tributary of
Spearfish Creek. In 1929, Johnny reportedly
discovered one of the Black Hills' largest gold
nuggets weighing 7.346 troy ounces.

The nugget, and Johnny, became famous after
the find. In 1934, businessman W.E. Adams
bought the nugget. In 2014, the nugget went
on permanent display at the Adams Museum.
Johnny is buried in Mount Moriah Cemetery.

HISTORY NUGGETS SETH BULLOCK

Seth Bullock spent a lifetime trying to make Deadwood a permanent, prosperous place for future generations.

He and his business partner Sol Star arrived in Deadwood to open a hardware store in August 1876. Two days before they arrived, Wild Bill Hickok was gunned down. After the killing, the town decided it needed a sheriff. Bullock, a former lawman in Montana, took the job. He later engaged in several businesses including a hotel that bears his name, a flour milling company, mining ventures and a ranch near present-day Belle Fourche.

He met future president Teddy Roosevelt in 1884, and the men developed a lifelong friendship. Bullock and 50 South Dakota cowboys rode horses in Roosevelt's inaugural parade in 1905.

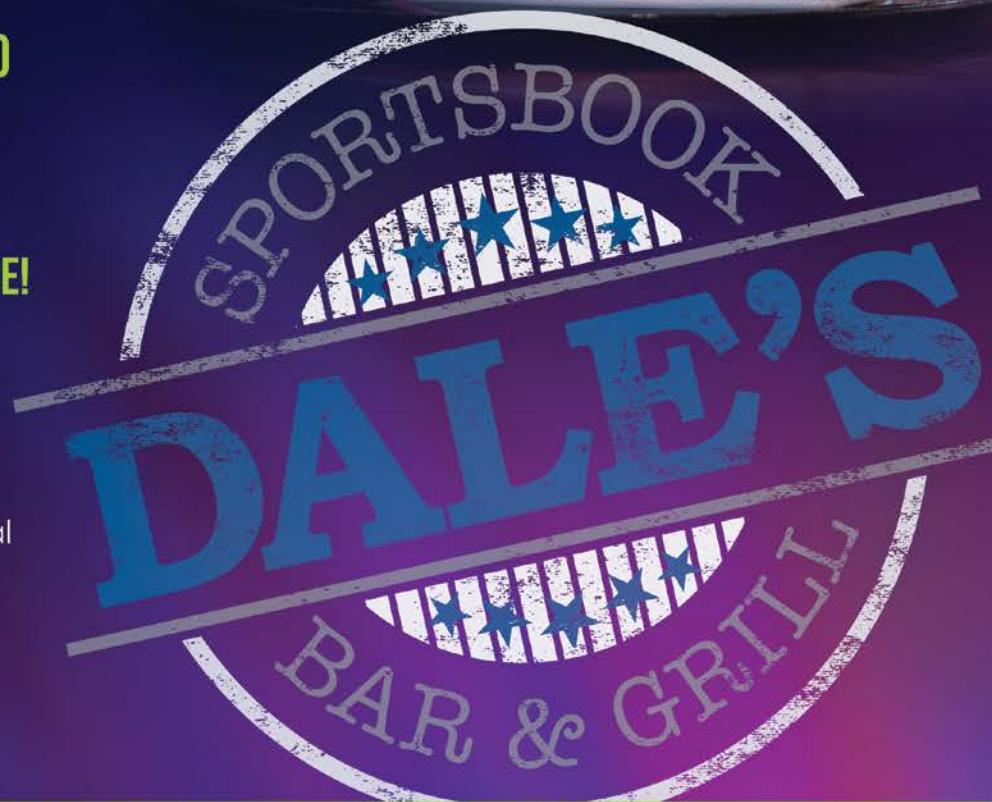

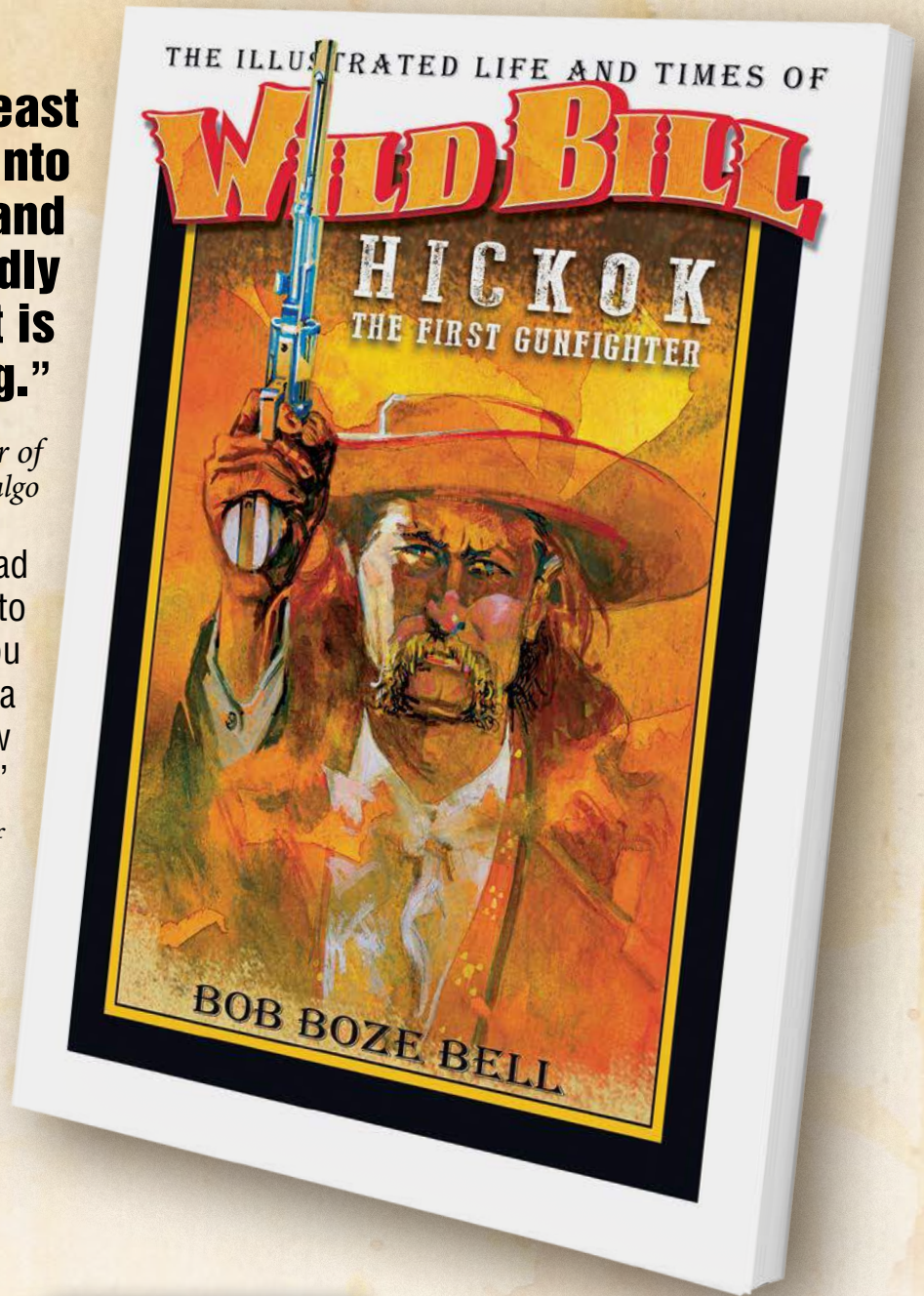

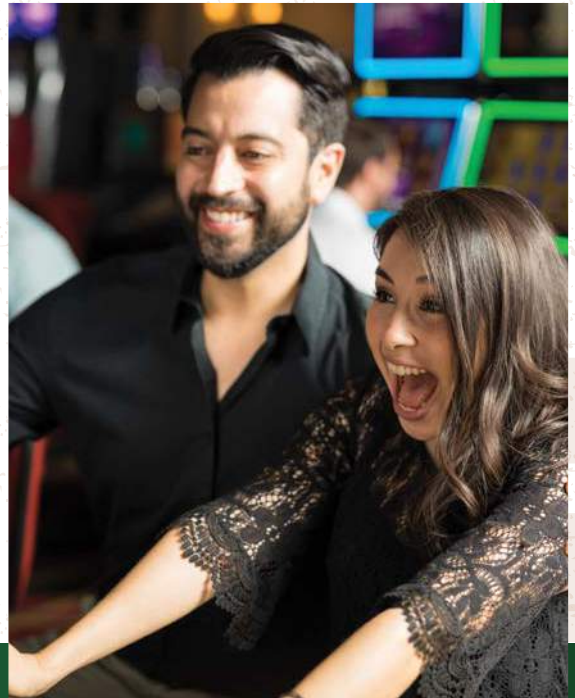

HISTORY NUGGETS POKER ALICE

One of Deadwood's more colorful characters in the early days was Alice Ivers Tubbs, better known as "Poker Alice." Most historians believe that Poker Alice was born on February 17, 1853 in Devonshire, England, although some purport that she was born in Virginia to Irish immigrant parents.

The Ivers family moved to Leadville, Colorado, at the height of its gold rush when Alice was just a teenager. Alice blossomed into a beautiful young girl. She met and married a young mining engineer named Frank Duffield. They shared a love of poker — he was good, but she was better.

After Frank died in a mining explosion, Alice supported herself by gambling full time. She traveled to various Western boomtowns, and by the turn of the 20th century, she was playing the tables in Deadwood's Badlands district.

In Deadwood, Alice met second husband Warren G. Tubbs, an avid gambler who made a living as a painter in Sturgis. After Warren died in 1910, Alice opened a gambling house and brothel between Sturgis and Fort Meade. With the advent of prohibition, she also became a bootlegger. In 1930, Alice died and was buried at the Aloysius Cemetery in Sturgis.

From locally crafted spirits to fine dining and full-day pampering, there are countless ways to treat yourself right in Deadwood.

WINE TASTING

Sample wine made from grapes grown in the Black Hills at the Belle Joli Winery Tasting Room (594 Main Street). There's outdoor seating on the patio, and the wines on offer include traditional reds and whites, as well as dessert and sparkling wines. Up the street is Naughti Winery (692 Main) offering a playful take on traditional grape wines.

LOCAL BREWS, WINES & SPIRITS

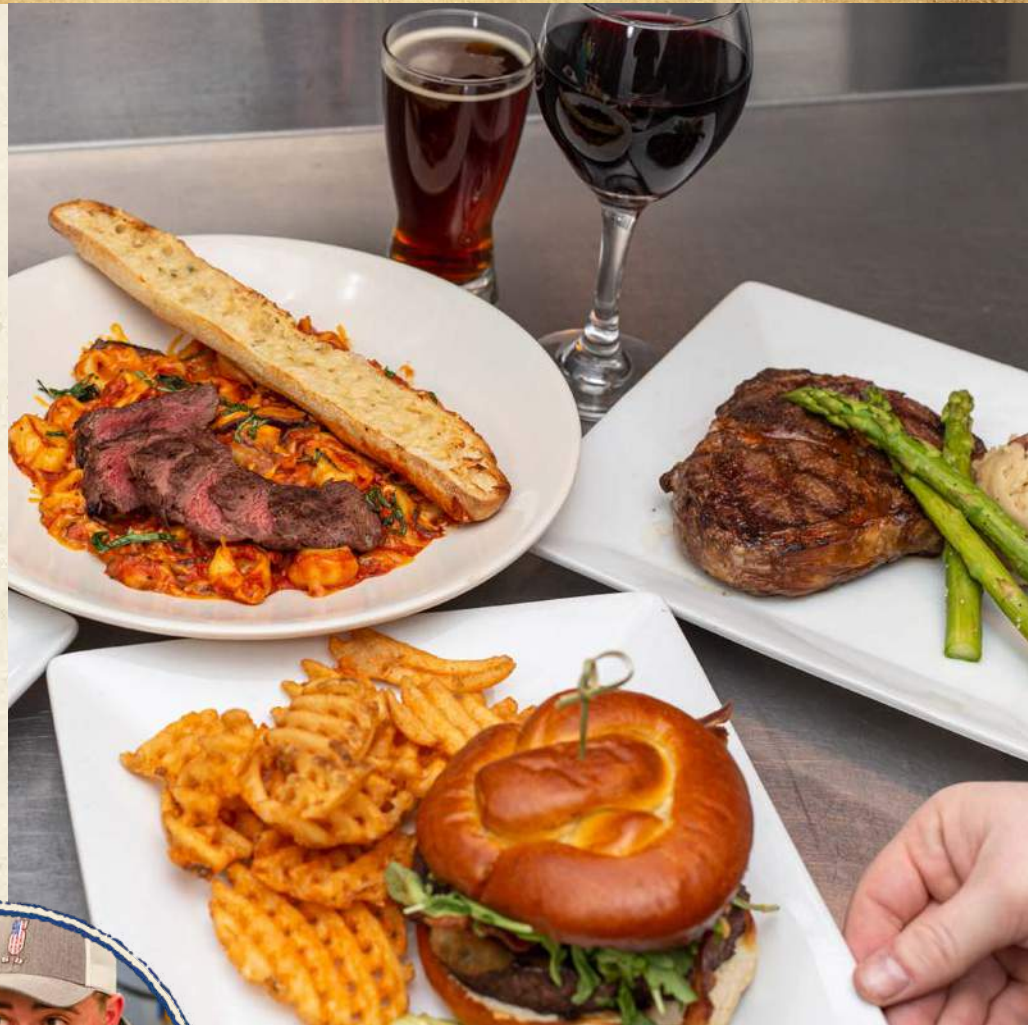
Thirsty for a bigger taste of South Dakota? Try some locally made drinks at Deadwood's bars and saloons such as Jacob's Brewhouse (79 Sherman Street). Beer drinkers should ask bartenders about brews made in the area. If wine is more your style, ask about bottles from the vineyards of Belle Joli and Prairie Berry. Both make wines in South Dakota. Looking for a serious kick? Check out the moonshine at Deadwood Distillery (645



Main Street) and the whiskey at West River Whiskey (644 Main Street).

CIGAR BAR

The iconic architecture of the old Masonic Temple building (715 Main Street) will be the first indication that you're in the right place. If you're a cigar and tobacco aficionado, the Deadwood Tobacco Co. & Cigar Bar welcomes you into a 7,000 square foot, newly remodeled space where you'll find cigars, loose-leaf tobacco, wine, more than 70 different beers including their very own Deadwood Tobacco Company porter.



FINE DINING

Looking for a nice restaurant for a date night? You have plenty of upscale dining options. For a taste of regional ingredients, try the Deadwood Social Club (657 Main Street), just above the Saloon No. 10. The martini bar and outdoor fire pit add to the ambiance. Favorite dishes include the bison ravioli and smoked pheasant tuaca. For aged and hand-cut steaks, head for the Deadwood Legends Steakhouse, on the lower floor of the 1903 Franklin Hotel (700 Main Street). Aside from steaks, signature dishes include shrimp crepes and Colorado rack of lamb. The Gem Steakhouse and Saloon, in the Mineral Palace Hotel (601 Main Street), offers hand-cut steaks (aged at least 21 days) and fine wine in a fun



atmosphere. The menu is based on the real-life characters from the Deadwood HBO series. Dale's in Deadwood Mountain Grand (1906 Deadwood Mountain Drive) provides an upscale dining experience, whether it's a light lunch or elegant dinner. In summer, the restaurant has an outdoor dining patio overlooking Whitewood Creek. The Deadwood Grille at The Lodge at Deadwood (100 Pine Crest Lane), offers a spacious and elegant dining experience. Their chef-inspired menu features unique appetizers, a large wine selection, and popular dishes including seafood and unique steaks like the Tomahawk Chop and Tatanka Filet. Snitches (555 Main Street) at Tin Lizzie Gaming Resort offers a chef-inspired

gastronomic experience crafted using local and seasonal ingredients. Unique flavor combinations and menu offerings, a first-rate restaurant atmosphere and their own smoke-meats are a few of the things that make Jacobs Brewhouse and Grocer (79 Sherman Street) a new favorite in Deadwood. Jake's (677 Main Street) at the Midnight Star casino, offers fine dining with a view from of the tallest building on Main Street. Flyt Steakhouse by Alpine Inn (360 Main Street) specializes in small plates and flights of options. Ask about the Flyt of the Night and Flyt Dessert.



DAY SPAS & SALONS

Need a vacation from your vacation? There are three day spas in Deadwood to help you relax. Stress Relief Massage & Spa (802 Main Street)

provides a full array of massage and spa services. Akela Spa (11842 U.S. 14) is perched on a hilltop just a mile east of town. Akela Spa provides traditional spa services, but it is probably best-known for the dry sauna, housed in a Lakota-style tipi. The town's newest relaxation station is Deadwood Day Spa (93 Sherman Street), a full service spa featuring a variety of massages, and therapies like eucalyptus steam and salt. When your hair or skin needs a little help, stop at Salon 14a, just north of town at the Highway 85 and 14a intersection.



SWEET TREATS

Chocolate connoisseurs would do well to visit Chubby Chipmunk (420 Cliff Street) where the handmade truffles are the main attraction, and they also have ice cream and candies. Don't let the humble storefront fool you; Chubby Chipmunk has been asked to supply chocolates for guests at the Country Music Awards, Oscars and the GRAMMY Awards. If you're a sweets for breakfast type, Deadwood has several places to grab fresh baked goods in the morning. Lou Lou's Bombdiggity's (11 Charles Street) specializes in a variety of pastries, including a decadent caramel roll big enough for two (or three) and donuts. Then, stop at Jacob's Grocer (79 Sherman Street) and ask about their homemade pop tarts and croissants. Looking for a scoop? Hard serve ice cream is available at the Big Dipper (652 Main Street) and at Lizzie Burgers, located at Tin Lizzie Gaming Resort (555 Main Street).

HISTORY NUGGETS THE BADLANDS

Much of early Deadwood tried to put on a genteel Victorian front, but the area of saloons, brothels and gambling parlors along lower Main Street made no attempt at respectability.

The Badlands, also home to Deadwood's tiny Chinatown neighborhood, was well known for its wild and woolly ways. The notorious Gem Theater and the Green Front Saloon were Badlands landmarks. So was Nuttal & Mann's Saloon, later named the Saloon No. 10, where Wild Bill Hickok was murdered.

Archeologists in recent years have recovered more than 250,000 artifacts from this area, offering a fascinating picture of this infamous section of town. If you want to see the former Badlands for yourself, check out Main Street from Wall Street to the intersection of Highway 85 near the lower Main Street parking lot.



HAVE A PARTY IN DEADWOOD



In Deadwood, the party started back in 1876, and if you think they knew how to party back in the day, wait until you see what we have in store for you now!



Whether you're looking to celebrate your favorite holiday, root for your favorite rodeo cowboy, or dance to your favorite song, there's something happening in Deadwood, every month of the year.

HOLIDAYS WITH ATTITUDE

If you're looking for an excuse to dress up, Deadweird is the Halloween party to rule them all. The Pub Crawl during the St. Patrick's Celebration weekend and parade on Mardi Gras also offer excellent opportunities to get out your best get-ups. Oktoberfest, and even the Wild West Songwriters Festival provide great excuses to get out on the streets and have a great time.



DAYS OF '76 RODEO & CELEBRATION

Named a PRCA Rodeo of the Year for 19 years, the Days of '76 Rodeo shows these cowboys aren't messing around. Between events, be sure to catch one of the Main Street parades celebrating Deadwood's

colorful history and heritage. This event takes place every July.

FALL EVENTS

Fall events kick off with the Deadwood Jam mid-September, followed by Hops & Hogs: Bear & Bacon festival a week later, and then Oktoberfest the first weekend in October. The rest of the season doesn't slow down, the Wild West Songwriter's Festival is mid-October and Deadweird follows on the weekend closest to Halloween.

KOOL DEADWOOD NITES

For five days at the end of August, join us for classic cars, classic music and classic fun. Bring your own classic car into town to show off, or just come up and see the beauties brought in by the rest of the crowd. With a show n' shine, car auction, guided tours along scenic routes during the day, followed up with a sock hop and free concerts in the evening, this event is a car lover's dream.



FOOD & DRINK FESTIVALS

Enjoy Deadwood's culinary pleasures when you attend one of the town's many festivals centered around food, wine and beer tastings. Tickets allow you to sample the specialties

offered by vintners, brewers, distillers from all over the region and paired with food samples from Deadwood chefs. Deadwood has three food and beverage-based festivals per year, two in the spring and two in the fall.

GIRLS & GUYS GETAWAYS

Make a date to bring your mates to Deadwood. Male bonding experiences can include golf (5 courses a short drive from Deadwood), UTVs (600 miles of off-road motorized trails), a cigar bar and blackjack, poker, roulette and craps in Deadwood's casinos. HAVE ADVENTURES OUTDOORS IN DEADWOOD



HIKE, BIKE OR RIDE THE MICKELSON TRAIL

If you're ready for a challenge, the northernmost trailhead of the 109-mile Mickelson Trail departs from Deadwood. This former rail line takes you past historic mining buildings, over creeks and into the Black Hills. Passes are available at stations along the trail, at a Deadwood Visitor Center or online. Bike rentals, Ebikes, and shuttles are available May through mid-October. Horseback riding is also available.

OFF- ROADING

Deadwood is located in the heart of the 1.2 million acres of the Black Hills National Forest. Off-road enthusiasts can take off on the Forest's

Motorized system consisting of 600 miles of designated trail bisecting with 3,600 miles of unpaved roads. Adventurers can rent ATVs and UTVs at area outfitters or bring their own vehicles. The trail system requires a modest weekly or annual fee for use and you must have a valid drivers license for travel on roadways.

SNOWMOBILING



Snowmobiling is a great way to traverse the Black Hills National Forest in the winter, especially in the 5,500+ feet elevations surrounding Deadwood.

The backcountry commonly builds a 5-foot snowpack for off-trail riding and the National Forest is home to a 350-mile network of marked, mapped and groomed trails. One of those trails leads directly into town! Snowmobile rentals are available at several trail-side outfitters near Deadwood.

DOWNHILL, CROSS COUNTRY SKIING & SNOWSHOEING

Winter is an excellent time to visit Deadwood. Downhill slopes are located within 15 minutes drive from the historic town. If you didn't bring your gear, don't worry. Rental equipment is available on-site and at area outfitters.

Prefer a slow and steady pace? Cross country skiing on pristine snow or groomed tracks is plentiful around Deadwood. Rentals are available at area

outfitters. Snowshoeing is another great way to explore backcountry and hiking trails in the Winter. Many state parks in South Dakota as well as Game, Fish & Parks offices and the Deadwood Welcome Center have free snowshoe rentals.

FISHING

The Black Hills National Forest is ripe with fresh streams and man-made lakes making it a popular destination for many different types of fishing. A variety of species of fish call the Black Hills home, including brown, brook, and rainbow trout, as well as northern, perch, and crappies can be found in its fresh waters. Best of all, the fishing season never ends. Warm weather days in the summer are perfect on the lake. Or, if setting up a small tent on the ice during the cold winter months is your idea of solitude,



that's an option too. For fly fishing enthusiasts, Black Hill Fishing Guide offers packages to suit any skill level and more.

Remember, fishing licenses are required to fish in all public areas. Licenses, handbooks, maps and other



important information is available at many local retailers as well as local Game, Fish and Park locations in the Black Hills.

METAL DETECTING & GOLD PANNING

Gold panning and metal detecting on public land (ie: the Black Hills National Forest) is technically allowed, but you'll need to find land that is unclaimed. That's harder than you might think. Remember, mining in this area has been ongoing since the mid-1870s. Mineral claims on public land are managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). Visitors are encouraged to call the BLM for more information at **605-892-7000**, or the Northern Hills District of the Black Hills National Forest Service at **605-642-4622**. For those willing to plan ahead, and pay a fee for the right to prospect, joining a club is the easiest way to gain access to a claim. The Black Hills Prospecting Club (local) and the Gold Prospectors of America (national) both have several claims nearby and membership information on their websites.

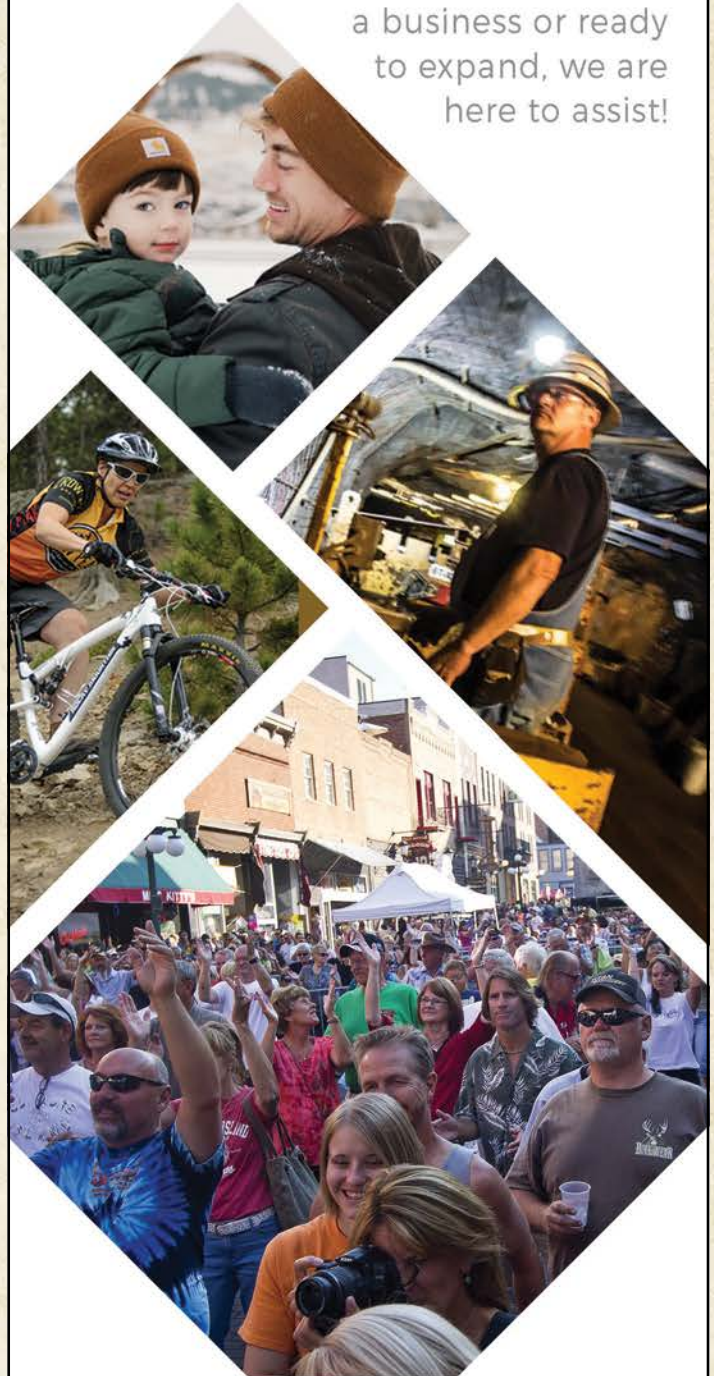

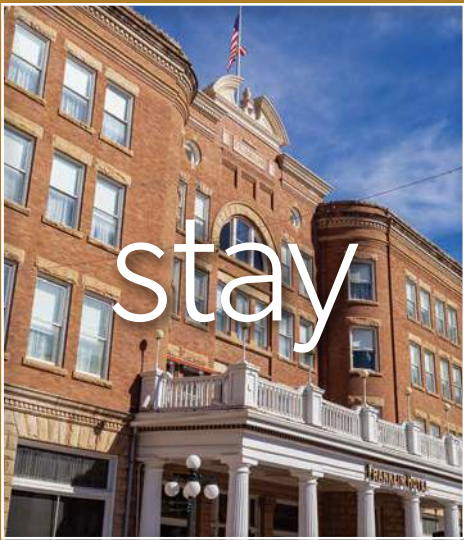

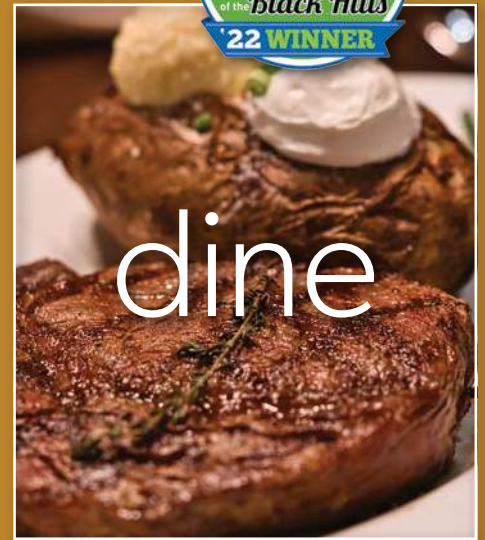
