

Deadwood Wild Bill Days Vendor Market and Festival

Fees: \$100 covers both days 10'x10' space. \$40 additional fee for electricity (limited spaces)

Rules (subject to be modified or changed)

- The Deadwood Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to refuse any booth that does not comply with the standards set by the City of Deadwood.
- Food and drink vendors with items available for immediate consumption (food trucks ect.) will not be allowed. Packaged food items will be considered.
- All vendors are required to send and attached file(s) and a description of goods they are selling.
- Payment must be made upon selection by the cutoff date of June 8th, 2026. Payments will be made to The Deadwood Chamber of Commerce by cash, check, or CC. All booths must be paid in full before set up can begin.
- All exhibitors are responsible for collecting and reporting their own sales tax.
- Vendors must provide a copy of their SD Sales Tax License. Please send a copy with the return of this application.
- All exhibitors are responsible for furnishing and setting up their own booth/tent.
- Tents will not be provided. All tables, signage, canopies, ect must be furnished by the vendor
- Vendors may not park vehicles or trailers on Main St next to or behind their booths.
- Free parking is available at the Deadwood Welcome Center, first come first served.
- Vendors are required to be present for the whole duration of the event.
- Vendors must comply with related federal and state laws, South Dakota codified laws, and the SD Department of Health and regulations.
- Set up will begin at 6am on Friday June 19th. Vendors must follow set up procedures set by the event: **No vehicles will be allowed in the vending area. Designated staging areas will be available, and staff will have golf carts/ATVs to help assist moving items in the vendor zone. Please plan ahead to carry/hand truck items in with assistance from staff in golf carts. This will happen on a first come first serve basis.**
- Tear down will begin at 8pm Saturday June 20th. **Again, no vehicles will be allowed in the vending area. You will be responsible for carrying items out to the staging areas with the assistance of market staff in ATV/Golf Carts. All vendors must complete load out by 11pm.**
- Hours of the event will be 10am – 8pm each day on Friday June 19th and Saturday June 20th.
- Overnight security will be provided so vendor spaces may remain set up Friday night.
